

Banner Good Samaritan Medical Center has undergone a major renovation and expansion in order to accommodate the increasing number of patients the center serves and to provide improved facilities for staff. The vision for the project was established through a series of imaging sessions attended by Banner Health and the entire design team which defined the project's goals and objectives and which has served as the "vision touchstone" throughout the design process.

The concept for the overall campus' site design was inspired by the profound success of the medical center's Healing Garden, completed in 1996, with Floor & Ten Eyck as part of the collaborative design team. Floor Associates was subsequently chosen by Banner Good Samaritan Medical Center to expand the healing garden concept throughout the entire Medical Center campus. The new design creates a strong entry to the facility and a renewed sense of place throughout the campus. Intimate healing gardens link the campus buildings and provide quiet refuge for patients and visitors alike.
